

# Earning Graduate Course Credit for Knowles Academy Courses

The Knowles Teacher Initiative partners with Southern New Hampshire University (SNHU) to offer graduate credit for Knowles Academy course participants. Participants can earn three graduate credits for each course they take. Graduate credits are not available for pilot courses.

## Earning Credit

To earn course credit, you are expected to fully participate in the Knowles Academy course. Requirements for full participation are:

- Attend and actively participate in all in-person course workshops.
- Attend and participate in all follow-up meetings, virtual or in-person. Depending on the course, possibilities include in-person sessions or video chats throughout the year. Your instructor or coach will schedule meetings and video chats with you.
- Complete all applicable course surveys (i.e., pre-workshop, post-workshop, mid-year, and end-of-year surveys) distributed by your course instructors.
- Communicate with your instructor or coach throughout the year.

Failure to fully participate will affect your grade in the course. If something about the course is preventing you from fully participating, you should contact one of your course instructors immediately.

Grades for courses taken in summer 2019 will be submitted to SNHU by May 31, 2020 to allow time for all follow-up to be completed. You will be able to request a transcript that reflect the credits earned from SNHU after that date.

## Cost

Graduate credits cost \$125/credit hour or \$375 per course. This cost is in addition to the course registration fee.

## Registration

To register to earn graduate credit from SNHU, please indicate your interest on the Knowles Academy course registration form. Knowles staff will follow up with you to arrange for payment and provide the SNHU registration link.
